Crime Analysis Report

PERIOD: 1st to 31st December, 2017

1. Major Crimes:

- Total **171** incidents countrywide for the month of December 2017.
- **↑** 8% (13 incidents) **increase** compared to **December 2016**, and an **increase** of 11% (17 incidents) compared to the previous month, **November 2017**.
- **49%** Belize District
- **16%** Stann Creek District

In year 2017, there was a 7% (145 incidents) **decrease** in Major Crimes. Murder and Robbery incidents **increased** while Rape, Burglary, Theft and Unlawful Sexual Intercourse **decreased** respectively. (See Annex)

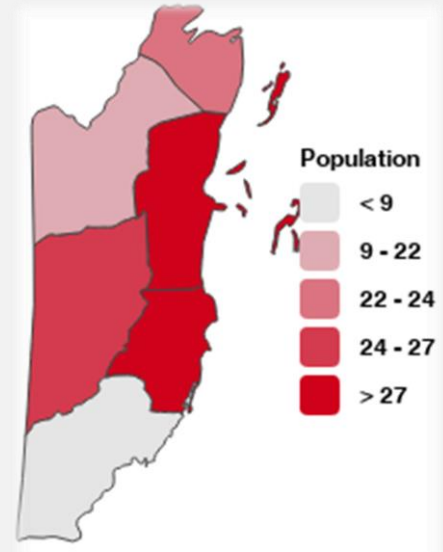


Chart A: Major Crimes Data for December 2017, by location

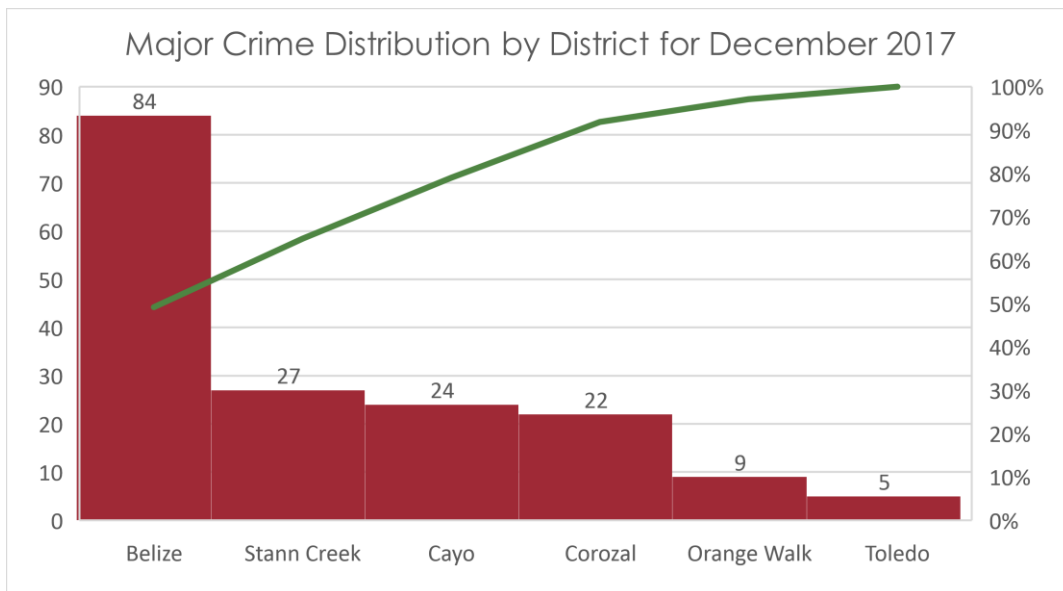
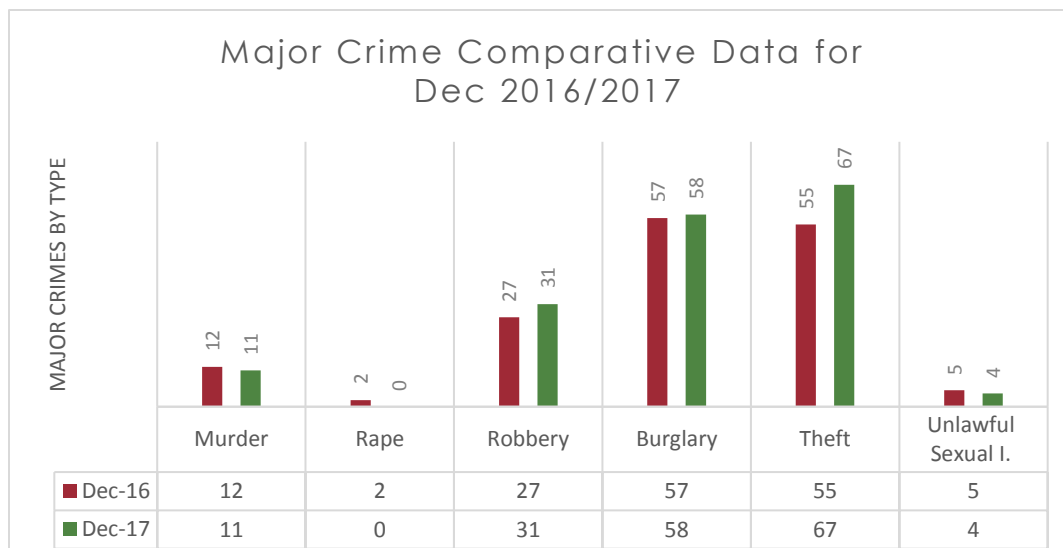


Chart B: Major Crimes Comparative Data for December 2016/2017

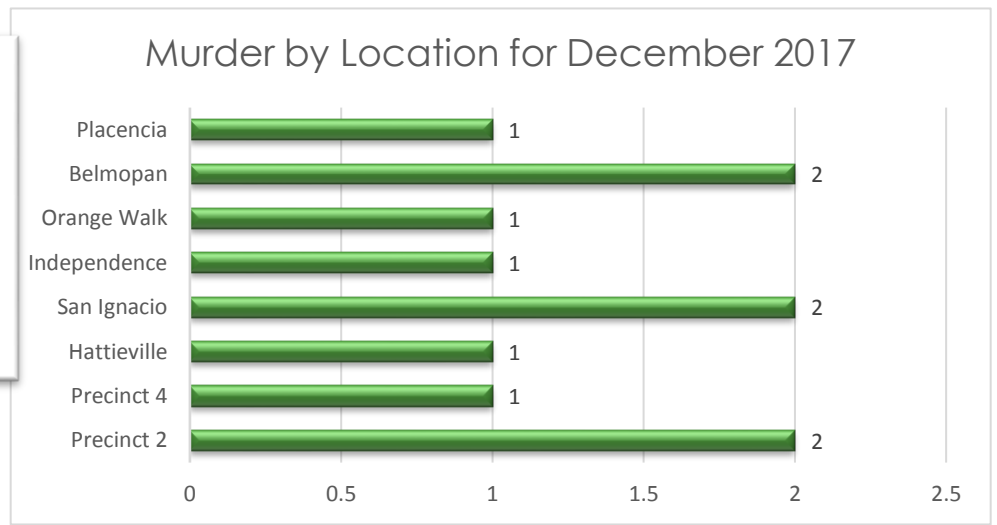

Property Crimes

Robbery/Burglary/Theft:

Of the **(171)** major crimes that occurred in December 2017, **Robbery, Burglary, and Theft contributed to 91% (156)** with RBT being **(31/18%), (58/34%)** and **(67/39%)** of incidents respectively.

Belize District has the highest total number of RBTs in the country: Robbery **(12/8%), Burglary (29/19%),** and Theft incidents **(38/24%).**

The **Stann Creek District** reported the **second highest number** of RBTs in the country closely followed by the **Corozal District** for the month of December 2017.

Chart D: RBT Total Dec. 2017

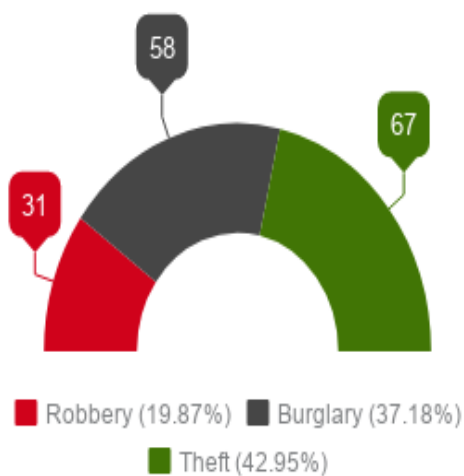


Chart E: RBT Data by District

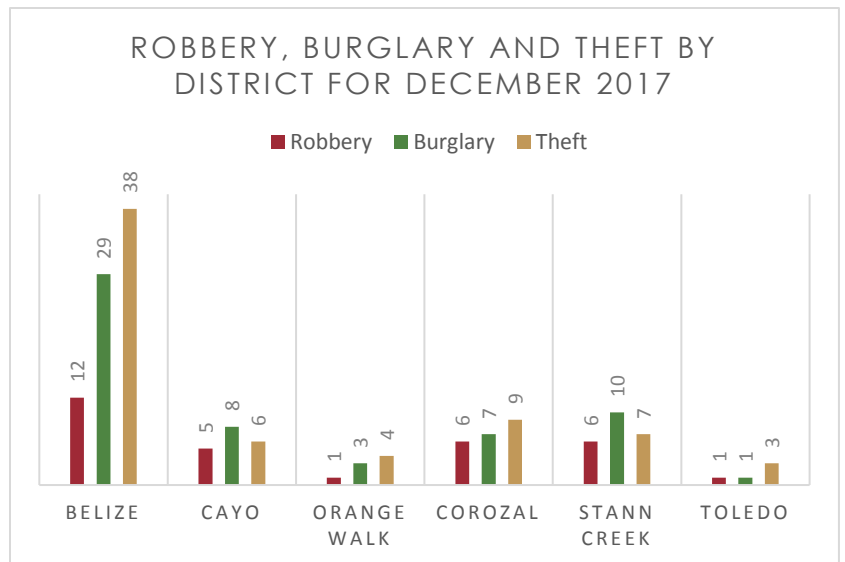
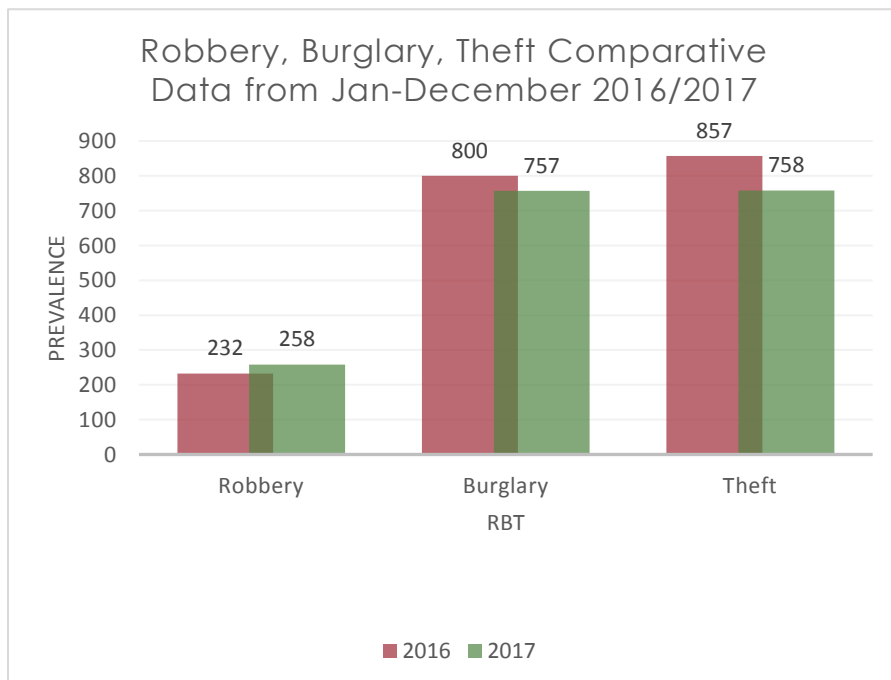


Chart F: RBT Comparative Data from Jan-December 2016/2017
